2017 NYSSA VINTAGE SLED SHOW: BIGGER AND BETTER!

- ✓ Sled registration is \$5.00 with a \$20 maximum for an unlimited number of sleds.
- ✓ Sleds cannot be registered in multiple classes.
- ✓ Friday Sled Unload Times: Between the hours of 12:00 pm and 5:00 pm.
- ✓ Saturday Sled Unload Times: Between the hours of 7:00 am and 10:00 am.
- ✓ Open parking for trailers only will be on the outdoor skating rink.
- ✓ Saturday Registration Opens: 8:30 am
- ✓ **Saturday Sled Judging will begin as soon as the sleds enter the complex and are set up.**
- ✓ Awards will be announced at the Awards Luncheon on Saturday – **Lunch tickets sold separately.**
- ✓ Please bring your own tables and chairs. There is a charge to rent tables and chairs from the Convention Center.
- ✓ Sleds delivered on Friday will be locked inside the convention center for the evening. Security will be onsite for the duration of the event.

Original Class – Snowmobiles must be all original. Only mechanical replacement parts and windshield replacements are allowed. Snowmobiles may have touch up paint on skis and suspension. Tunnels and hoods cannot be repaired or retouched. Seats can be reupholstered.	
Restored Class – Snowmobiles restored back to “Showroom Condition”. All replacement parts are allowed in the restored class to bring the machine back to its original specifications.

11 Custom Class (Any Year) (1 st , 2 nd & 3 rd Place Trophies) Any snowmobile that is not original and has been modified from its original state can be entered. Any year, any make, any model.	
12 Most Unique (1 st , 2 nd & 3 rd Place Trophies) For ages, snowmobilers have been finding or building their own unique renditions of snowmobiles. Bring your unique snowmobile in for a chance to take home the top dog award.	
13 Cutter Combo Class (1 st and 2 nd Place Only) Cutters have been around the sport since almost the first snowmobile was built. Bring your cutter by itself or with a tow sled. Any year cutter can be entered to win.	
14 Mini Class (1 st and 2 nd Place Only) Kids have been riding miniature snowmobiles since they have been around. The mini class is the perfect place for your child or the child in you to showcase your 120cc or less miniature snowmobile.	
15 Forgotten Wonders (1 st , 2 nd & 3 rd Place Trophies) Back in the days of old, snowmobiles were manufactured by dozens of companies. Many of whom have long since stopped production or completely gone out of business. Bring your forgotten wonder for a chance to show off your snow machine.	
16 Delegates Class (1 st Place Plaque Only) All attendees who are registered as NYSSA voting delegates can enter their snowmobile of any year, make or model free of charge. This class is <u>only</u> for voting delegates. No others will be entered.	No Charge
17 Farthest Traveled (1 st Place Prize Only) Farthest traveled from “home” to Lake Placid.	No Charge
18 Best of Show (1 st Place Plaque Only) Snowmobile collectors typically collect more than just snowmobiles. Bring your snowmobile collection of vintage snowmobile clothing, patches, helmets, saddle bags, etc. for display. Tables are not provided. Bring your own tables and chairs or rent them through the conference center.	No Charge
19 People’s Choice (1 st Place Plaque Only) The People’s Choice award is the pinnacle of vintage snowmobile awards in New York State. Every registered Forum attendee, voting delegate and vintage show participant will be given a ballot to vote for the best snowmobile in the show. All registered sleds are eligible to win.	No Charge
